### Notice of Motions

#### **2. Motion from Councillor Enda McGloin:**

Can I ask for a summary report of how many local authority houses are currently vacant, awaiting works in the Drumshanbo area and if the members could get a report on what plans this council has to build or purchase housing stock. Finally, if we could get an overall idea of how many applicants are currently on the Housing Waiting List for the Drumshanbo town area.

**3. Motion from Councillor Enda McGloin:**

I call on the Council to provide emergency repairs to the road; L-33031, Lavour towards the upper section of the mountain road. There are some severe potholes that need to be filled.

**4. Motion from Councillor Ita Reynolds Flynn:**

I call on the Council to provide road markings to improve parking safety at the outreach graveyard Ballinamore.

**5. Motion from Councillor Ita Reynolds Flynn:**

I request the Council to provide road signage at The Keeldra Walk Trail and at Cornageeha (known locally as Sean's cross L1567 and L1609 2).

**6. Motion from Councillor Brendan Barry:**

I request that the Council resurface the L13431-0 in the townland of Curraghnawall, Corraleehan. What if any works are planned for this section of road in the short to longer term?

**7. Motion from Councillor Brendan Barry:**

While I welcome the commitment I was given at the last meeting of Leitrim County Council to provide salt bins at Shanleys Hill, Keshcarrigan and at the bend beside Dohertys near Letterfine, will a staff member be designated to spread that salt during times of freezing temperatures or snowfalls? What is the capacity in kg of rock salt that the gritting lorry which passes Letterfine can carry? Will the Council seriously consider adding the 2.4km from Letterfine to Keshcarrigan village to the Winter Maintenance Plan? Keshcarrigan should not be left isolated from a route on the Winter Maintenance Plan.

**8. Motion from Councillor Gerry Dolan:**

I call on the Council to have repair works carried out on the upper half of the Laragan Rd, Drumshanbo. (L730.51/0)

**9. Motion from Councillor Gerry Dolan:**

I call on the Council to have repair works and resurfacing works carried out on the Cornabaine Road, Aughnasheelin, (L53/29/0) which have been damaged by forestry works in the area.

**10. Motion from Councillor Caillian Ellis:**

I will ask the Council what progress has been made in relation to one off houses and how many Planning Permissions have been granted in the Ballinamore Municipal District for 2019 - 2020?

**11. Motion from Councillor Caillian Ellis:**

I propose that Ballinamore Municipal District write to the Minister for Agriculture, Food and Marine, Charlie McConalogue with a view to having a drainage grant put in place for the West of Ireland for a five year period.

**12. Motion from Councillor Paddy O'Rourke**

I propose that the Ballinamore Municipal District contact the Department of Agriculture and ask them to provide all the farmers who participated in the BEAM Scheme last year with up to date figures as to where they stand regarding the 5% reduction in Bovine Nitrogen produced on their holding which roughly equates to a 5% reduction in herd size (subject to the classification of their animal dairy or beef). Farmers need to know where they stand in order to take the necessary action altering their herd size in the time remaining in order to avoid a claw back of the money, they received last year.

**13. Motion from Councillor Paddy O'Rourke**

I ask that the Council carry out the necessary repairs on the road leading from the former Station House at Adoon leading to join the L55151 serving the town land of Cornagher. Both roads require urgent attention.
