3. Motion from Councillor Sean McDermott:

When will the work under the Minor Flood Scheme commence on the Glenaniff River?

4. Motion from Councillor Sean McDermott:

I ask for the Japanese Knotwood that is growing at the new graveyard in Rossinver to be

treated.

5. Motion from Councillor Padraig Fallon:

With Brexit only weeks away and to acknowledge the many friendships and relationships which have been formed over the past 22 years between the border communities of Garrison and Cashel in Fermanagh with those of Askill, Rossinver and Kiltyclogher in Leitrim, I ask that the Manorhamilton MD send a Christmas cards to the Garrison Community Group and to the Cashel Community Association to show our commitment to them in the years ahead.

9. Motion from Councillor Felim Gurn:

Manorhamilton is one of the only towns in Leitrim that does not have a river walk. Can the Council look at the possibility of creating a river walk from Hamilton's Castle down to the Courthouse area within the town and investigate possible funding streams to progress such a project.

10. Motion from Councillor Felim Gurn:

Dromahair is a village that has increased in population dramatically in the last 15 years and yet does have a Community Centre. Can the council consider the Garda barracks as a potential source to provide a Community Centre in the future?

11. Motion from Councillor Mary Bohan

I propose that the Council examine the possibility of providing traffic calming measures on the Dowra Road on the approach to Drumkeeran village.

12. Motion from Councillor Mary Bohan

I propose that the Council contact the Minister for Agriculture again in relation to a compensation package for farmers affected by the Dawn of Hope landslide.
