Notice of Motions

5. ***Motion from Councillor Pádraig Fallon***

I propose that peat, earth and debris arising from the landslide at Dawn of Hope which has been placed on turf banks be removed, and that this Municipal District calls on the Local Authority and Coillte to engage with those whose turbary rights have been impacted.

6. Motion from Councillor Padraig Fallon:

What is the current level of vacant Local Authority housing in North Leitrim, and if a breakdown of family or 3 beds or greater can be included?

7. Motion from Councillor Sean McDermott:

I am asking if potholes can be filled on local roads in North Leitrim as many of these roads have become unsafe. I understand since the present Covid-19 restrictions Council staff have been restricted to carry out works except in emergencies. Can these necessary repairs be carried out safely within the Covid-19 restriction guidelines?

8. Motion from Councillor Sean McDermott:

I have raised the issue in the past of an old disused sewer pipe in the village of Kiltyclogher, located near the library. This pipe is very unsightly and dangerous if it were to topple over. I am asking for it to be removed.

9. Motion from Councillor Justin Warnock:

I ask our CEO Lar Power, is distance a disadvantage when applying for a job with Leitrim County Council if you live north of the N15. With only a handful of staff from this area currently employed out of a population of approx. 5,000 residents, there is a perception locally that this is the case.

10. Motion from Councillor Felim Gurn:

Can executives give the number of people who have been relocated through Focus Ireland into the Manorhamilton Municipal District?

11. Motion from Councillor Felim Gurn:

There has been a lot of bags disposed of at church lane beside the Dillon court apartment building, not in their private car park and a lot of anti-social behaviour with Gardaí being called on regular basis. This behaviour is causing a lot of anxiety for residents beside the apartment block. Is it the management of the building or the owners of the apartments, that are responsible for the behaviour of the residents to make it a safe environment for neighbours of the apartment block?

12. Motion from Councillor Frank Dolan:

Can I ask is there any truth in the rumour that the bring centre in Manorhamilton may not

reopen when the current restrictions are lifted?

13. Motion from Councillor Frank Dolan:

There is an ongoing problem at the bottom of the Carrickanurroo road, Fivemilebourne, where the water is coming off the road and flowing into Sadie O'Hara's yard, I ask if this could be addressed.

14. Motion from Councillor Justin Warnock:

I ask that Leitrim County Council commit to an advertising campaign and increased signage to prevent dog owners from taking their dogs onto the mountains of this Municipal District. There has been a significant increase in dog attacks on sheep, resulting in the death of many. There has also been a number of altercations between farmers and dog owners and farmers at times have felt threatened by this thuggish behaviour. This is totally unacceptable and the goodwill that farmers have shown to hillwalkers in recent years could be lost if this issue is not addressed.
