- 4. Motion from Councillor Caillian Ellis:

I propose that Ballinamore Municipal District repair the depression in the road in Cloone Village.

5. Motion from Councillor Caillian Ellis:

I propose that Ballinamore Municipal District carry out works on the road verges on Local Road Numbers L5561 and L5569 in the townland of Sunnaghmore.

6. Motion from Councillor Ita Reynolds Flynn:

Can I request an update on Local Studies in Ballinamore Library please.

7. Motion from Councillor Ita Reynolds Flynn:

I call on Ballinamore Municipal District to investigate subsidence on Road No. L1553.

8. Motion from Councillor Enda McGloin:

I call on Ballinamore Municipal District to request the Road Design Department to consider new road markings and a pedestrian safety study alongside a new tarmacadam surface around the Mayflower roundabout and junctions at Carricknabrack, Drumshanbo.

9. Motion from Councillor Enda McGloin:

I call Ballinamore Municipal District to write to the Department of Transport requesting them to provide a properly funded budget for the refurbishment of some local footpaths, currently there seems to be no source of funding to repair dangerous sections of our footpath network in the county.

10. Motion from Councillor Brendan Barry:

I request that Ballinamore Municipal District call on the HSE to provide a building for the Leitrim/West Cavan Children's Disability Network Team. The team and its patients need a building with therapy rooms and office space to maximise the amount of time Therapists will have to help the children of the area and therefore not spending time in cars and traffic travelling to several different buildings.

11. Motion from Councillor Brendan Barry:

I request that Ballinamore Municipal District carry out pedestrian safety and traffic calming measures in Keshcarrigan beside Ceis Lawns, on the Drumshanbo road and the Astro Pitch on the Mohill road. Residents are very concerned about pedestrian safety in the village.

12. Motion from Councillor Paddy O'Rourke:

I ask that Ballinamore Municipal District carry out a short stretch of resurfacing on road No: LT15882-0 in the town land of Beaghmore, approximately 300 metres south of Glan Cross. This should be carried out in order to prevent the further deterioration of this road which is carrying a great deal of traffic.

13. Motion from Councillor Paddy O'Rourke:

I ask Ballinamore Municipal District when will the works to make Greagh Cross safe be completed? While the signage and other measures have assisted in a small way, the reduction of the hill on the approach from the Drumnamore side, which blocks the view of those crossing from Fenagh to Aughavas and vice versa, is the only long-term solution. I understand adjoining landowners are agreeable to having the water mains resited within their property.

14. Motion from Councillor Gerry Dolan:

I call on Ballinamore Municipal District to have a public light erected outside Ballinaglera Hall.

15. Motion from Councillor Gerry Dolan:

I call on Ballinamore Municipal District to have "Slow Down" signs erected, to allow people crossing the road to the footpath from the houses at Acres, the Drumshanbo side of the swimming pool.
