Notice of Motions

6. Motion from Councillor Thomas Mulligan

In light of the ongoing difficulties for traffic on Hyde Street and the Dromod Road Mohill, which is part of the Regional Road No. R202, a solution, such as a link from the Dromod Road to Coolabaun must now be identified and funding sought from the Department.

7. Motion from Councillor Sean McGowan:

I call on the Senior Engineer, Terry McGovern, to carry out a review, in conjunction with the Gardaí, of the speed limits on Local Road No. L-1001-0 at Aughnahunshin Rooskey with a view to reducing them to 50 Kmph, and also to look at the possibility of installing rumble strips along the road. Motorists tend to speed along this section of road, where there are three housing estates and a number of single houses and with young children & elderly people living along this road, they are concerned for their safety with the speed on this road.

8. Motion from Councillor Sean McGowan:

I ask Mr Darragh O'Boyle, District Engineer, to put in place a programme of works to carry out the cleaning of the footpath from the railway bridge to the Fairways Housing Estate in Dromod, as it is covered in moss and is extremely dangerous and slippery for pedestrians who use it daily. In addition, there are two public lights out of order along this footpath for the past number of months.

9. Motion from Councillor Des Guckian:

That, under Active Travel, a footpath / cycleway be built to join the entrance to Cornee Lane to St Patrick's Church, Mohill.

10. Motion from Councillor Des Guckian:

That all the lay-bys along road L7471-0, Antfield to Drumcoora to Drumcree, be opened up again and a few more added.

11. Motion from Councillor Enda Stenson:

The pedestrian crossing at Tranemore Mohill on the R201 is still dangerous, as traffic approaching from the Carrick side, continuously fail to stop. Are there any measures we can take to ensure it is a safe crossing point for pedestrians?

12. Motion from Councillor Enda Stenson:

Is there a timescale in place for the commencement of the long awaited Carrick on Shannon bypass?

13. Motion from Councillor Finola Armstrong McGuire:

I ask what is the delay in switching on public lighting in the new Local Authority housing estate of Pairceanna na Baile, Carrick-on-Shannon?

14. Motion from Councillor Finola Armstrong McGuire:

I ask that a report is requested from TII regarding the monitoring of traffic on the N4, out of Carrick towards Attyrory/Attyfinlay, specifically at the roundabout servicing Rosebank Retail Park.

15. Motion from Councillor Paddy Farrell:

I call on District Engineer, Darragh O'Boyle, to look for funding to repair the other bridge on the L-7409-0 at Gowel as this old bridge causes severe flooding after heavy rain. There are two bridges on this road, one of which was constructed recently, and a brilliant job done, by Leitrim County Council.

16. Motion from Councillor Paddy Farrell:

I am getting a lot of complaints about road markings on the R-280 at the Kiltoghert and Ballinamore turnoff, known locally as the Fingerboard. I call on Leitrim County Council to investigate and address the issue at this location.
